

Introspect

Introspect has been developed by the Russian Institute of Practical Psychophysics, and is a revolutionary invention. Introspect is a machine for data controlled strain assessment and is a result of many years cooperation between Russian scientists. Strain indicates stress on an organ or area of an organ. The spectral result is then compared with the strain creating patterns of various conditions and also possible strain reducing remedies. This enables the possible identification of stressors.

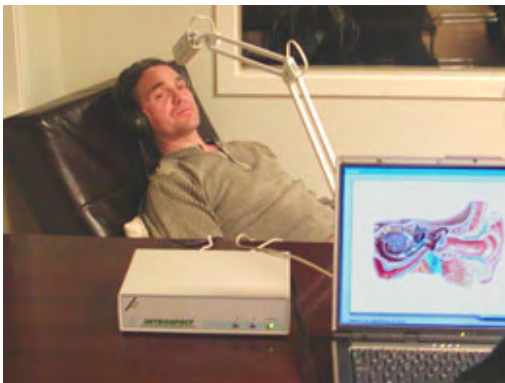


The data for comparison originates from actual physiological comparisons on a large data population over many years.

Introspect Oberon assesses the body at the cellular level. There are no other methods today that can find strain at the same early stage that the Introspect Oberon does. Since the strain on an organ will vary with lifestyle, diet etc. this is taken into consideration in the assessment analysis.

The method is based on an analysis of the brain stems electromagnetic waves which contain the complete information of the entire organism. This information is read by a very low level laser. A frequency transmitter aimed at the projection area of the brain stem stimulates this electromagnetic radiation.

Introspect first and foremost measures where in the body there is any strain. The frequency of several thousand healthy and sick organs and tissues have been measured for several years by the Russian researchers, and these make the basis of comparisons for the measurements. If the patient's frequencies in an organ or tissue are near the average of a healthy organ or tissue it is considered normal- its functional response is satisfactory for the person's age. The greater the difference is, the more stressed is the organ or tissue. Should the patient's results coincide with the average strain frequency of an organ with a specific illness a hint is provided to the possible dysfunction. All the measurements account for age and sex.



Introspect can also indicate strain related imbalances from microflora, bacteria, parasites etc in different organs. The software uses the electromagnetic frequencies for these items, measured and then stored in the database. In the same way the stored information from remedies can be used to assess possible items to assist stress reduction.

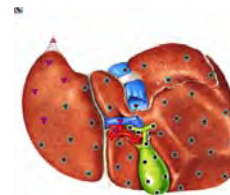
The Introspect can do a Quantum Medical treatment called Meta- Therapy. The machine repairs the organism using a diversity of modulated electromagnetic waves. This treatment stimulates the body's own functions so that they solve the problem and it

stimulates the immune defense. The therapy does not deal with physiological issues but with the “memory” or information that accompanies and issue. The meta-therapy treatment of “operating software” requires other approaches to address the hardware effects- remedies etc. This takes around 10 seconds per organ, and is a very good supplement or alternative to traditional treatment. The patient can follow on the screen how the organ progressively gets better, and afterwards one can take a new measurement showing the improvement.

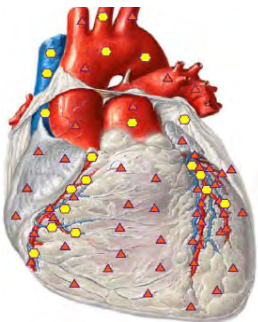


The Introspect Oberon can scan many parts of the body, including:

- *cardiovascular*: heart and circulation system, arteries, veins
- *respiratory*: lungs
- *digestive*: stomach, small and large intestine, liver, gallbladder, pancreas
- *reproductive system*: testicles, ovaries, uterus, vagina, penis
- *musculo skeletal system*: bones, muscles, spine
- *immune system*: thymus, lymph, immune cells (neutrophils etc.)
- *urinary*- bladder, kidneys



and allows a deeper focus on especially strained areas.



Introspect Oberon gives no side-effects, and has many important advantages compared to traditional diagnostic methods. One of the most important advantages is that one finds out if an organ is weak and has reduced function, even if there is no other indication of disease. No other machine can find problems and weaknesses as easy and as early in the disease progression cycle.

The Introspect Oberon is in reality designed & developed for doctors, but it can also be of great help to other therapists.
